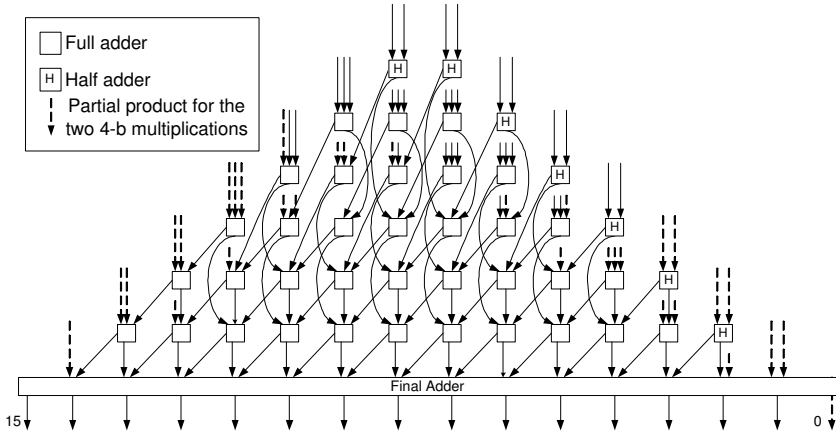


Figure 1.1: Some text that describes the picture.
